- Lilly Endowment National Clergy Renewal Program
  - Will provide grants of up to \$50,000 each directly to congregations for getting started the support of a renewal program for their pastor.
  - The costs associated with family members who accompany a pastor may be included in the amount requested for the pastor.
  - Up to \$15,000 of the grant may be used to help the congregation fulfill pastoral duties during the pastor's absence and/or to support activities that enable the congregation as a whole to be renewed in its ministry.
